Day 10 - February 21 (Thursday) – Jerusalem

On our third day in Jerusalem you will have an opportunity for a “free day” without any bus or guide. You can take the time to revisit the **Old City of Jerusalem** (our hotel is within walking distance), spend the day exploring, shopping, or just relaxing at the hotel.

Day 11 - February 22 (Friday) – Jerusalem to Tel Aviv

We will plan a late morning check-out before boarding our bus to return to Ben Gurion Airport. However, before we arrive at the airport, we will take one more opportunity to visit the **Garden Tomb, Herodian National Park, Ellah Valley (Tel Azaka), and Tel Beit Shemesh**. We will have a farewell dinner in **Abu Gosh** before your transfer to the airport, with a lifetime of memories, for our overnight flight back to the US.

We arrive in our gateway city, and from there you will fly to your departure city with new insights into the Bible, the people, and the land of Israel!

Trip Information

COST for the trip is **\$3,495 per person** (double occupancy). An additional cost of **\$625 for a single**, or anyone requesting a private room.

COST INCLUDES round-trip airfare from your departure city; good, 4-star hotels for nine nights; nine breakfasts and ten dinners per plan; a St. Peter’s fish lunch at the Sea of Galilee; travel by private motor coach for nine days with bi-lingual Hebrew and English-speaking Christian tour guide; admission to the sites we visit during the trip (including Masada cable car); one Audio Guide System wireless headset device per traveler; and all taxes and fees.

COST DOES NOT INCLUDE a United States Passport (good for at least six months *after* the trip); medical coverage; lunch each day (except for the St. Peter’s fish lunch in Galilee); beverages at meals; souvenirs; internet; phone calls; portage services; tips for bus driver, guide, hotels and restaurants; and any other miscellaneous personal expenses.



Day 1 - February 12 (Tuesday) - To Tel Aviv

You leave from your departure city to travel to the group's gateway city. From there, the group will fly together to **Tel Aviv**, Israel.

Overnight: On the airplane

Day 2 - February 13 (Wednesday) - Tel Aviv

Shalom! Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in **Tel Aviv** this afternoon, we will transfer to the Hotel Metropolitan for an overnight stay.

Overnight: Tel Aviv Meal: Dinner

Day 3 - February 14 (Thursday) – Tel Aviv to Galilee

We will check out of the hotel and travel to Immanuel Church Lutheran in **Joppa** for a worship service this morning. We will have the opportunity to see the interior of this beautiful church, with its many stained-glass windows and the organ with 1,200 pipes and 18 stops (built by Paul Ott, from Gottingen, Germany). We will also visit Simon the Tanner's house in Joppa; and then travel along the coast of the **Mediterranean Sea** to the ancient seaport of **Caesarea**, where the Apostle Paul was imprisoned. Next we will continue on to **Mount Carmel**, and **Tel Megiddo**. This evening we check in to Nof Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel in **Galilee** for our overnight.

Day 4 - February 15 (Friday) – Galilee

Today our group will take a boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee**; visit **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' activities in Galilee; **Tabga**, the traditional site where Jesus fed the 5,000; **Mount of Beatitudes**, **Magdala**, and **Mount Arbel** overview. While at the Sea of Galilee, we will enjoy a St. Peter's fish lunch. We overnight at Nof Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel again.

Day 5 - February 16 (Saturday) – Galilee

We will board our bus and travel to **Nazareth**, Jesus' childhood home and visit **Nazareth Village**, a re-creation of life during the time of Jesus; **Upper Galilee**, the archaeological site of Tel Dan, with a gate from Abraham's time. We will continue on to the **Golan Heights**, with a visit to the **Banias Nature Reserve**; and the **Mount Bental** overview. We return to Nof Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel, Galilee, for a final night at this hotel.

Day 6 - February 17 (Sunday) – Galilee to the Dead Sea

This morning we head to the **Jordan River**, on the southern tip of the Sea of Galilee, to the **Yardenit** baptismal site, where John the Baptism baptized Jesus. After visiting this site, we travel on to **Beit Shean**, mentioned in the Bible several times, and best known as the site where King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls. From here we travel through the **Jordan River Valley** and on to **Qumran**, the site of the community that discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls in 1947. We check in to the Hod Hotel, **Dead Sea**, to enjoy the spa.

Day 7 - February 18 (Monday) – The Dead Sea to Jerusalem

We begin this busy day with an exciting trip to **Masada**, site of the Jews' final stand against the Romans in 73 AD, ascending by cable car to view the remains of Herod's palatial palace. Then on to **Ein-Gedi**, where David hid from Saul and composed some of the Psalms. We continue on to **Jericho** to see the site where the battle of Jericho took place. Next we visit **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus, where we will see the 6th century **Church of the Nativity**, the **Shepherd's Field**, and other sites. Finally, we make our way to **Jerusalem** with a stop at the **Mount Scopus** overview on the way to our hotel, Prima Kings Jerusalem.

Day 8 - February 19 (Tuesday) – Jerusalem

On our first day in Jerusalem we will see places like the **Mount of Olives**, the **Palm Sunday Path**, the **Garden of Gethsemane**, the **City of David**, the southern steps of the **Temple Mount**, the **Western Wall**, and the **Jewish Quarter**. Finally, we finish at Israel's official Holocaust memorial, the **Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum**.

Day 9 - February 20 (Wednesday) – Jerusalem

On our second day in Jerusalem we will see places like the **Church of St. Peter** in Gallicantu, the **Upper Room**, **Mount Zion**, **Lion's Gate**, **St. Anne's Church** and the **Pools of Bethesda**, **Antonio's Fortress**, and the **Via Delorosa**. We will also visit the **Israel Museum** and take in the sound and light show at the **Tower of David Museum**.
