

# Tour Itinerary (continued)

## Day 10 - October 22 (Thursday) – Jerusalem

On our third day in Jerusalem you will have an opportunity for a “free day” without any bus or guide. You can take the time to revisit the **Old City of Jerusalem** (our hotel is within walking distance), spend the day exploring, shopping, or just relaxing at the hotel.

## Day 11 - October 23 (Friday) – Jerusalem to Tel Aviv

We will plan a late morning check-out before boarding our bus to return to Ben Gurion Airport. However, before we arrive at the airport, we will take one more opportunity to visit the **Garden Tomb, Herodian National Park, Ellah Valley (Tel Azaka), and Tel Beit Shemesh**. We will have a farewell dinner in **Abu Gosh** before transferring to the airport for our overnight flight back to the US, filled with amazing memories of walking in the footsteps of Y’shua.

# Trip Information

**COST** for the trip is **\$3,995 per person** (double occupancy). There is an additional cost of **\$825 for a single**, or anyone requesting a private room.

### COST INCLUDES:

- Round-trip airfare from your city of departure;
- Nine nights in selected basic to good 4-star hotels;

- Admission to sites we visit per plan, and guides at those sites;
- One Audio Guide System wireless headset device per traveler;
- All taxes and fees.

**COST DOES NOT INCLUDE** a United States Passport (good for at least six months *after* the trip); medical coverage; lunch each day (except for the St. Peter’s fish lunch in Galilee); beverages at meals; souvenirs; internet; phone calls; portage services; gratuities for bus driver, guide, hotels and restaurants (\$15/person per day collected at beginning of trip); and miscellaneous personal expenses.



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# Tour Itinerary

## Day 1 - October 13 (Tuesday) - To Tel Aviv

You leave from your departure city to travel to the group's gateway city. From there, the group will fly together to **Tel Aviv**, Israel.

## Day 2 - October 14 (Wednesday) - Tel Aviv

Shalom! Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in **Tel Aviv** this afternoon, we will transfer to the Hotel Metropolitan for an overnight stay.

## Day 3 - October 15 (Thursday) – Tel Aviv to Galilee

We will check out of the hotel and travel to Immanuel Church Lutheran in **Joppa** for a worship service this morning. We will have the opportunity to see the interior of this beautiful church, with its many stained-glass windows and the organ with 1,200 pipes and 18 stops (built by Paul Ott, from Gottingen, Germany). Then we will travel along the coast of the **Mediterranean Sea** to the ancient seaport of **Caesarea**, where the Apostle Paul was imprisoned. Next we will continue on to **Mount Carmel**, and **Tel Megiddo** overview (time permitting). This evening we check in to Ein Gev Kibbutz Hotel in **Galilee** for our overnight.

# "In the Footsteps of Y'shua"

## Day 4 - October 16 (Friday) – Galilee

Today our group will take a boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee**; visit **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' activities in Galilee; **Tabga**, the traditional site where Jesus fed the 5,000; **Magdala**, the village of Mary Magdalene; and **Mount Arbel** overview. While at the Sea of Galilee, we will enjoy a St. Peter's fish lunch. We will then board our bus and travel to **Nazareth**, Jesus' childhood home; and visit **Nazareth Village**, a re-creation of life during the time of Jesus. From there, we travel to **Mt. Precipice**.

## Day 5 - October 17 (Saturday) – Galilee

We begin our day with a visit to the **Mount of Beatitudes**, then to **Upper Galilee**, the archaeological site of **Tel Dan**, with a gate from Abraham's time. We will continue on to the **Golan Heights**, with a visit to the **Banias Nature Reserve**; and the **Mount Bental** overview.

## Day 6 - October 18 (Sunday) – Galilee to the Dead Sea

This morning we head to the **Jordan River**, on the southern tip of the Sea of Galilee, to the **Yardenit** baptismal site, where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. After visiting this site, we travel on to **Beit Shean**, mentioned in the Bible several times, and best known as the site where King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls. From here we travel through the **Jordan River Valley** and on to **Qumran**, the site of the community that discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls in 1947. We check in at the Hod Hotel, **Dead Sea**, to enjoy the spa.

# October 13–24, 2020

## Day 7 - October 19 (Monday) – The Dead Sea to Jerusalem

We begin this busy day with an exciting trip to **Masada**, site of the Jews' final stand against the Romans in 73 AD, ascending by cable car to view the remains of Herod's palatial palace. Then on to **Ein-Gedi**, where David hid from Saul and composed some of the Psalms. We continue on to **Jericho** to see the site where the battle of Jericho took place. Next we visit **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus, where we will see the 6th century **Church of the Nativity**, the **Shepherd's Field**, and other sites. Finally, we make our way to **Jerusalem** with a stop at the **Mount Scopus** overview on the way to our hotel, Prima Kings, **Jerusalem**.

## Day 8 - October 20 (Tuesday) – Jerusalem

On our first day in Jerusalem we will see the **City of David** (including the 3D movie & **Hezekiah's Tunnel**), the southern steps of the **Temple Mount**, the **Western Wall**, and the **Jewish Quarter**, **Upper Room** and **Mt. Zion**. Finally, we finish at Israel's official Holocaust memorial, the **Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum**.

## Day 9 - October 21 (Wednesday) – Jerusalem

On our second day in Jerusalem we will see places like the **Mount of Olives**, the **Palm Sunday Path**, the **Garden of Gethsemane**, **Church of St. Peter** in Gallicantu, **Lion's Gate**, **St. Anne's Church** and the **Pools of Bethesda**, **Antonio's Fortress**, and the **Via Delorosa**. We will also visit the **Israel Museum** and take in the sound and light show at the **Tower of David Museum**.
